2009/2010 CAUSBCA YOUTH CITY TOURNAMENT RULES

1. CHECK-IN: Check-in time for each squad is **30 minutes** prior to the scheduled bowling time. Substitutes and their coaches must arrive **one hour** ahead of the scheduled bowling time and bring a completed substitute entry form.
2. DRESS: All bowlers are expected to wear neat and appropriate attire. The Tournament Director reserves the right to ask any bowler to change out of inappropriate attire or be disqualified.
3. EVENTS: Events will include Team, Doubles, and Singles. Bowlers may only enter Double and Singles once. Bowlers may enter Team Event as often as they would like **but have to sign-up before the entry deadline. You must change at least two members of the team for each squad.** The first events bowled will count toward the All-Events total. Three games will be bowled in each event. Bowlers entering the Singles Event must enter the Doubles Event and vice versa. These two events will be bowled consecutively. Singles will precede Doubles.
4. SUBS: Substitutes are allowed for any of the events. Doubles partners are not allowed to bowl together as subs. Regardless if the bowler is subbing or qualifying on his/her own entry, the first scores bowled will be used towards the All-Events total.
5. ELIGIBILITY: All entrants must be currently certified through the CAUSBCA.
6. TEAMS: Teams must be composed of four bowlers. Teams may consist of all boys, all girls, or boys and girls mixed and may include bowlers of all ages.
7. AVERAGES: A bowler's highest league average will be used based on 2009/2010 CAUSBCA year book average based on a 21 game minimum. Bowlers without a CAUSBCA yearbook average will use a fifteen (15) game summer average. Bowlers without a CAUSBCA year book average or Summer average will use a fifteen (15) game average as of 11/12/2010. Bowlers without either of these may enter scratch if all eligibility requirements are met. **Anyone not having a yearbook average must furnish proof of average by including a league standing sheet with the Entry Form.**
8. HANDICAP: Handicap per game for each division shall be 90% of the difference between the individual's bowling average and 220.
9. DIVISIONS: There will be three (3) divisions in the Team Event regardless of gender, four (4) in the Doubles Event regardless of gender, and four (4) divisions in the Singles Event an All-events for Males and Females.

10. **TARDINESS:** Any player or team arriving late will begin play with score to begin counting on the frame being bowled. If a team refuses to start bowling because a full line-up is not present, it will forfeit all games that it declines or refuses to bowl.
11. **COMPETITION:** During competition, bowlers must remain on their scheduled lanes once tournament play has begun. Any bowler not present for his/her frame shall receive zero for the frame or frames missed, unless excused by a tournament official. Delays will not be permitted.
12. **ENTRY FEE:** Each event – \$7.00 Lineage, \$.25 Expense Fee, \$4.75 Awards and Scholarships. Anyone bowling all three (3) events is automatically entered into All-Events. Plaques/trophies will be purchased from the awards fee. Any remaining funds will be allocated for scholarship awards. No team or individual will receive a refund after entry forms and fees are received and processed.
13. **ENTRY CLOSING DATE:** Midnight **Monday, November 15, 2010**. Any entries postmarked the next business day will be accepted.
14. **AWARDS:** All awards will be presented at their local bowling centers. Awards will be given on a ratio of at least one (1) for every eight (8) entries or major fraction thereof in each division in the following categories: Team, Doubles, Singles, All-events Handicap, and All-events scratch with Male and Female awards given separately in the Singles, All-events Handicap and All-Events Scratch.
15. **SCHOLARSHIPS:** Scholarships will be awarded on a one (1) in five (5) ratio or major fraction thereof in the Male and Female All-events handicap division. Scholarship money collected from the participants in each division will be kept in that division. CAUSBCA eligibility & tournament rules will be strictly enforced..

NOTE: Any tournament entry paid by a returned check due to insufficient funds will not be processed until the entry form is resubmitted with a certified check or money order no later than the closing date, 11/15/2010. \$25.00 fee plus amount of check will be charged for all return checks.

CAPITAL AREA USBC YOUTH CITY TOURNAMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Please verify addresses for all bowlers bowling All-events for the purpose of submitting this information for scholarships.
2. Bowlers must enter all three (3) events – Team, Doubles, & Singles to qualify for scholarships.
3. Winners will be determined by their total All-events handicap score. Place in each category will be determined by how many scholarship entries there are in that category.
4. There will be two (2) categories – Male and Female. Money collected from the participants in each category will be kept in that category. All money donated will be divided equally between the two (2) categories. CAUSBCA is guaranteeing and donating \$300.00 each for Highest Male and Female All-events Scratch and donating \$2400 toward All-events handicap.
