2010 CAUSBCA WOMEN'S TOURNAMENT

1. The 2010 CAUSBCA Women's Tournament is certified with USBC and its rules shall govern this tournament.
2. USBC Championship Chevrons will be awarded to handicap champions in each event. The championship trophy will be awarded to the highest team handicap set and be displayed in the house they represent until the 2011 CAUSBCA Women's Tournament. The majority of team members will determine representation.
3. To be eligible for participation in the 2010 CAUSBCA Women's Tournament, a bowler must be a certified member of the Capital Area USBC Association prior to bowling in his/her first schedule event. Non-Members living within the jurisdiction of this Association who are not a member of another Association may enter by paying an unattached membership fee (\$17.00).
4. **Entrants must report previous tournament prize money won in any event of \$600 or more won within the past twelve (12) month period. She shall report the scores rolled, date, and position standing (USBC Rule 319d).**
5. Entries must be postmarked by 9/21 for Early Bird Rates (\$20 per event) or by 10/12 for Standard Rates (\$25 per event). The All Events Handicap fee is \$5 and All Events Scratch fee is \$10. All fees are due with the entry form. Any entry that does not have the correct fees will be returned to the captain and the team is not considered entered until all fees are paid. A \$25.00 fee plus amount of check will be charged for all return checks.
6. **ONLY USBC CERTIFIED AVERAGES WILL BE USED FOR THIS TOURNAMENT.** Each bowler entered must use her highest 2009-10 yearbook average. A bowler without a 2009-2010 yearbook average will use a 2010 Summer Average of 21 games or more. If a bowler does not have a yearbook average or summer average, she must use her highest established average for the 2010-2011 season (minimum of 12 games) as of October 15, 2010. Verification in writing of the 2010-2011 average must be submitted to the tournament director prior to bowler bowling in her first scheduled event. A bowler who does not have an established average from the methods listed above will bowl with a 230 average. Bowlers who must use 2010-2011 average should list average as TBD (to be determined) on the entry form.
7. The 10 or more pin increase in average provision of USBC Rule 319A-2 **does not** apply to this tournament. The tournament director has the discretion to rerate any bowler. If a bowler disagrees with the rerated average, they can request to withdraw from the tournament and receive a refund prior to the start of the tournament.
8. Bowlers failing to use a proper average, or make a correction, up to completion of the first game of their first event, shall disqualify her score if submitted average is lower than her actual average. If submitted average is higher, the higher average will be used.
9. All bowlers shall check-in with tournament officials at least 30 minutes before the competition event is scheduled to bowl. Any individual failing to appear at the scheduled time or who is not ready to bowl when play is scheduled shall begin play with zero (0) scored until the frame she actually begins bowling. If a team refuses to begin bowling because a full line-up is not present, the team shall forfeit all games they fail or decline to bowl.
10. **Two divisions in each event: Regular: Team 660 & over, Doubles 330 & over, Singles 165 & over Classic: Team 659 & under, Doubles 329 & under, Singles 164 & under.**
11. **Handicap in each event will be based on 90% of 230 using the 3 game handicap method.**
12. The prize ratio of 1:10 or major fraction thereof will be used to determine the prize pay out. The winning team in each division will win \$1000. The bowler winning the optional scratch all events division will win an entry to the 2011 NCS USBC Queens Tournament plus \$500.
13. The Tournament prize money will not be awarded until the winners' averages are verified and will be mailed out within 30 days of the end of the tournament, providing there are not any protests. Tournament checks will be voided after 90 days of the date on the check. Final Standings will be posted at www.raleighbowling.com.
14. A bowler may bowl more than once in the Team event, but not more than two (2) players on the same Team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings. A bowler's first bowled team score will count towards her All Events score.
15. Entrants may bowl in doubles/singles as often as she wishes but may cash only once with the same partner for doubles and only cash once in singles. So if Doubles is entered twice, Singles must be entered twice. First scores bowled in doubles/singles will count towards All Events. Bowlers must enter both doubles and singles events in order to bowl in either doubles or singles. Doubles event shall precede the singles event.
16. Any unmarried grade or high school student who has not attained the age of 18 must have the written consent of his/her parent(s) or guardian, and such written consent must be on file with the Tournament Committee at least one (1) week prior to bowling unless accompanied by her parents or guardian.
17. The lane conditions for the tournament will be the USBC WHITE pattern. Go to www.bowl.com for information about the pattern.
