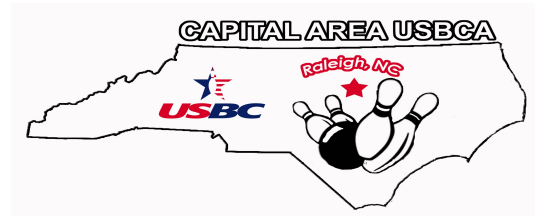


**All-Star Bowling Center Competition**  
**Tournament Rules**  
**2012**



**This year's tournament will be held at Rainbow Lanes at 4:00 pm on Saturday, April 21, 2012 Check-in no later than 3:15 pm.**

- All-Star Tournament participants will be based on youth bowlers from the perspective center who were sanctioned and bowled at least 30 games for the 2011-2012 season (excluding summer averages). Composite bowling center averages that are to be used are as of April 1, 2012. Qualifying bowlers must be certified through the CAUSBCA no later than January 14, 2012.

Note: Bowlers who qualify in more than one bowling center are allowed to choose which bowling center they would like to represent. A bowler can represent only one bowling center.

- The top four averages for both male and female youth bowlers from each of the following bowling centers: AMF Pleasant Valley, AMF South Hills, Buffalo Cary, Buffalo Erwin, Buffalo North, Buffalo South, Carolina Lanes and Rainbow Lanes and will bowl three games of scratch competition. Winners in both the male and female divisions will be determined by total pins knocked down in their division.
- The closing date for entries is April 13, 2012.
- The All-Star Tournament will be of no cost to the bowlers. The bowling center at which the tournament takes place will donate lineage.
- Each bowling center will purchase All-Star shirts for their youth bowlers.
- The Capital Area USBC Association purchased two plaques; one for the male division and one for the female division. The name of the bowling center will be inscribed on the respective plaque to be placed in the winning team's bowling center for one year to be followed by next year's tournament. The cost of the inscriptions will be covered by the Capital Area USBC Association.
- It is the Youth Director's and/or coach's responsibility to be sure their bowling center has a full team line-up the day of the tournament. Substitutions may be made the day of the tournament.
- Send the All-star lists to the Tournament Director via email. Lists are to include Names and averages of the All-Star team including up to 3 alternates that may be used as substitutes on the day of the tournament.
- This is a USBC sanctioned tournament.
- The winners for the All-Star Tournament will be announced immediately following the conclusion of the tournament.
- The Capital Area USBCA will sponsor a luncheon for All-Star bowlers before the tournament at approximately 3:00 pm.
