2012 BAKER DOUBLES TOURNAMENT RULES

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1. **RULES and REGULATIONS:** United States Bowling Congress rules and regulations will govern this tournament.
2. **ENTRANCE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:** Participation into the Baker Double s Tournament shall be available to all certified members of the Capital Area USBC Association prior to bowling in his/her first scheduled event. The tournament manager may refuse to permit any team or individual to bowl if it is determined that the entry should not have been accepted due to the individual(s) not meeting membership requirements.
3. **ENTRY FEES:** Entry fee in the tournament shall be \$25.00. Each official entry must be accompanied with a completed (all information filled in) form. No entry shall be accepted without fees. Any entry accompanied by payment not acceptable by the tournament manager shall lose its place in the tournament schedule and shall not be rescheduled until an acceptable payment is made.
4. **ENTRY FEE REFUNDS:** No team or individual shall be entitled to a refund after the form and fees have been received.
5. **AVERAGES:** Bowlers will use their highest 2010-2011 certified league yearbook average.
 - a. A bowler without a 2010-2011 yearbook average may use their highest 2011 summer average of 21 games or more.
 - b. A bowler who does not have a 2010-2011 yearbook average or 2011 summer average may use their highest 2011-2012 current average of at least 12 games as of March 1, 2012. **Written verification is required.**
 - c. A bowler who does not qualify under the above conditions must enter with a 230 average.
 - d. It is each bowler's responsibility to determine that the submitted average is correct. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average thereby resulting in more handicap or position standings. If the submitted average is higher, than the higher average will be used.
 - e. Average corrections can be made up to the end of the first game of the first event.
 - f. The 10 or more pins increase in average provision of USBC Rule 319A-2 **will not** apply for this tournament.
6. **AVERAGE RE-RATING:** The tournament manager reserves the right to re-rate average under USBC rules 319a-e. A bowler who has qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in any event in a tournament within the previous 12 month period must report actual scores, position and amount won to the tournament manager at time of entry for possible re-rating. Such re-rating must be accomplished before the entrant bowls and if not accepted by the entrant, the entry fee shall be refunded. Failure to comply with either of these provisions shall be cause to forfeit tournament entry fee and prize winnings.
7. **HANDICAP:** Handicap will be computed on a basis of 90% of the difference between each individual average and scratch average of 230.
8. **TOURNAMENT AWARDS:** The following tournament awards will be presented:
 - a. CASH AWARDS: Handicap Division: Cash awards will be made on a basis of 1:10 places.
 - b. CASH AWARDS: Scratch Division: Cash awards will be made on a basis of 1:6 places. Prize Fund returned 100%.
 - c. Tournament prize money will not be awarded until the winners' averages are verified and will be mailed out within 30 days from the end of the tournament, providing there are not any protests. Tournament checks will be voided after 90 days from the date on the check. Final standings will be posted on our website @ www.raleighbowling.com.
9. **SCHEDULING:** Entries will be scheduled for the shift requested (or if such shift has been filled, on the next shift available) in order of receipt in the hands of the tournament manager or by mail as evidenced by postmark. The tournament may cancel a shift when deemed in the best interest of the bowlers. Additional shifts and times may be added upon entries and lane availability.
10. **REPORTING TIMES:** All bowlers must check-in with tournament officials at least thirty (30) minutes before competition event is schedule to bowl. Any individual failing to appear at the scheduled time or who is not ready to bowl when play is scheduled, shall begin play with zero (0) scored until the frame he/she actually begins bowling. If a team refuses to begin bowling because a full line-up is not present, the team shall forfeit all games they fail or decline to bowl.
11. **COURTESY:** Only one (1) lane courtesy will be allowed.
12. **PAYMENTS:** Make all checks payable to Capital Area Tournament. **LIMIT ONE CHECK PER ENTRY.** A \$30.00 fee will be charged for returned checks. Entries with returned checks shall lose their place in the tournament schedule and will not be rescheduled until acceptable payment is made. Please do not send cash.
13. **ENTRY CLOSING DATE:** Entries must be postmarked by March 10, 2012.

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
